
An unconstrained global equity fund that seeks capital appreciation, measured in US dollars. Key Points:

- Emphasis on valuation, balance sheet leverage and maintaining a suitable margin of safety
- Focus on identifying investment opportunities in businesses and sectors that are experiencing operating difficulties or going through a difficult transition
- Long-term approach with a variant perception that is mindful of downside risk

The term "margin of safety" is the difference between the intrinsic value of the stock and its market price. Buying with a margin of safety means buying the stock well below what you think it's actually worth i.e. its intrinsic value.

Beta is a measure of the volatility of a portfolio relative to the overall market. A beta less than 1.0 indicates lower risk than the market; a beta greater than 1.0 indicates higher risk than the market. It is most reliable as a risk measure when the return fluctuations of the portfolio are highly correlated with the return fluctuations of the index chosen to represent the market.

Standard Deviation is an indicator of the portfolio's total return volatility, which is based on a minimum of 36 monthly returns. The larger the portfolio's standard deviation, the greater the portfolio's volatility.
