FUND OVERVIEW

- The Fund aims to generate a high income on your investment.
- The Fund invests globally in the full range of assets in which a UCITS may invest, including equity securities (e.g. shares), fixed income (FI) securities (such as bonds), funds, cash, deposits and money market instruments (i.e. debt securities with short term maturities).
- The Fund is actively managed and the asset classes and the extent to which the Fund is invested in these may vary without limit depending on market conditions and other factors at the investment adviser's (IA) discretion. In selecting these, the IA may take into consideration a composite benchmark comprising MSCI World Net Index (70%) and the Bloomberg Global Aggregate Bond Index USD Hedged (30%) (the "Index") when constructing the Fund's portfolio, and for risk management purposes to ensure that the active risk (i.e. degree of deviation from the Index) taken by the Fund remains appropriate given the Fund's investment objective and policy. Whilst the Index is used by the IA in constructing the portfolio of the Fund, the IA is not bound by its components or weighting when selecting investments. The IA may also use its discretion to invest in securities not included in the Index in order to take advantage of specific investment opportunities. The Fund's portfolio holdings are expected to deviate materially from the Index. The components of the Index (i.e. MSCI World Index and Bloomberg Global Aggregate Bond Index US Hedged) may be quoted separately in marketing material related to the Fund.

KEY RISKS:

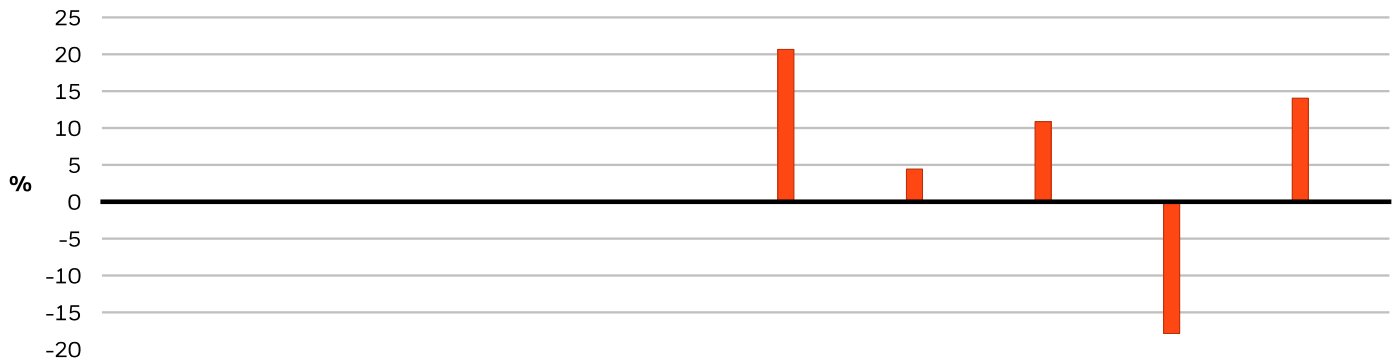

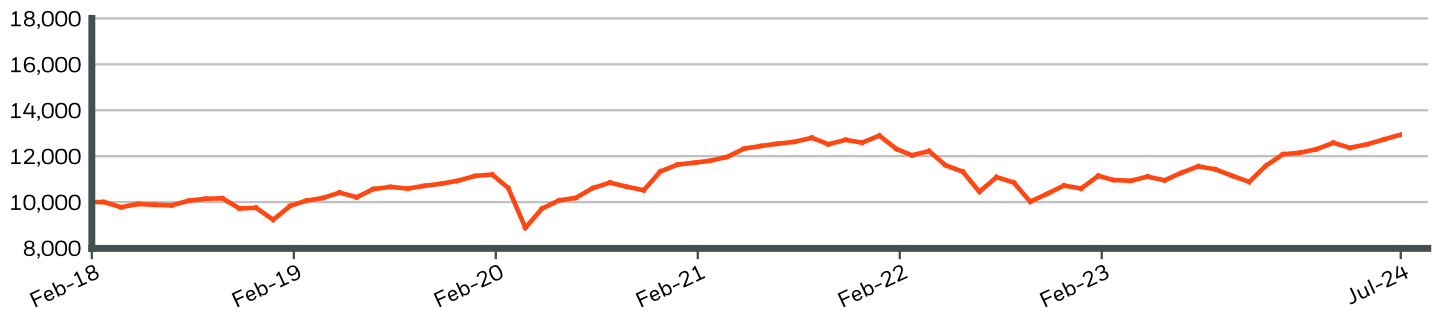

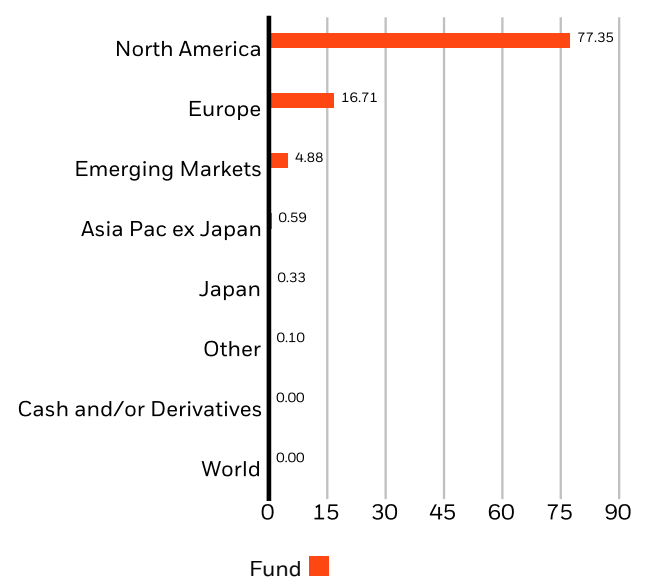

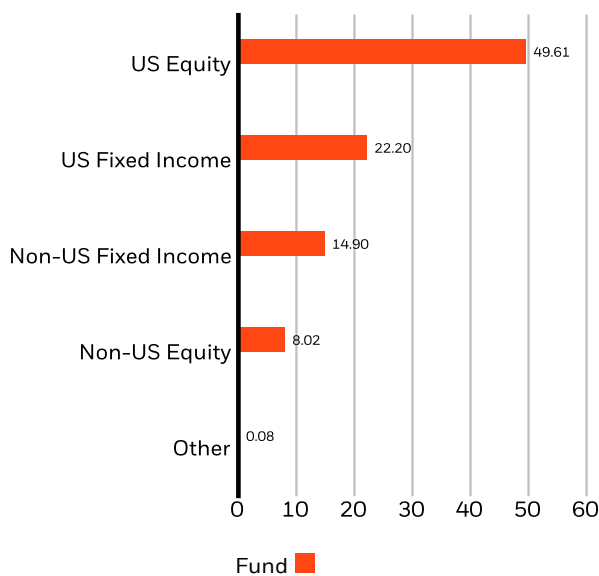

REGIONAL EXPOSURE (%)



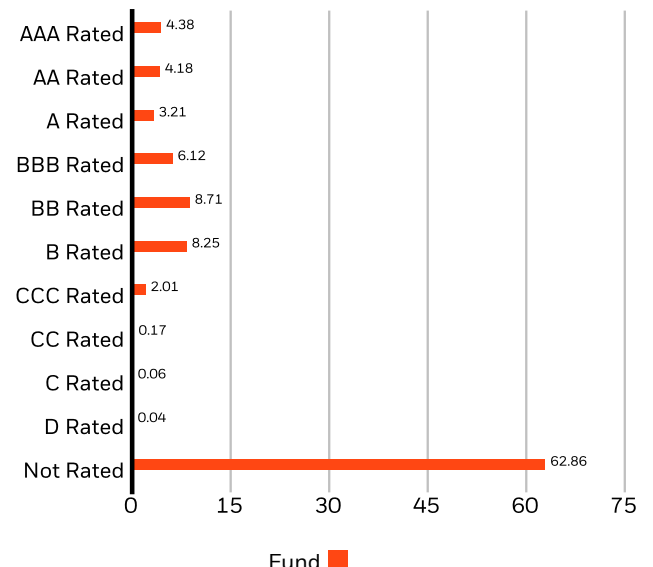

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GLOSSARY

SFDR Classification: Article 8: Products that promote environmental or social characteristics and promote good governance practices.

Article 9: Products that have sustainable investments as an objective and follow good governance practices. **Other:** Products that do not meet the criteria to be classified as Article 8 or 9.

Modified Duration: A measure of price sensitivity of a bond to changes in interest rates. The Modified Duration of the fund is calculated as the average of the underlying bonds' modified duration values, adjusted to take account of their relative weight (size) within the fund.

Price to Earnings: A valuation ratio of a company's current share price compared to its per-share earnings in the current forecast year, calculated as current share price divided by current earnings per share.

Average Market Cap: The average market capitalization of a fund's equity portfolio gives you a measure of the size of the companies in which the fund invests. Market capitalization is calculated by multiplying the number of a company's shares outstanding by its price per share.

Price to Book Ratio: represents the ratio of the current closing price of the share to the latest quarter's book value per share.
