# HSBC MSCI WORLD CLIMATE PARIS ALIGNED UCITS ETF

**Investment objective**

The Fund aims to track as closely as possible the returns of the MSCI World Climate Paris Aligned Index (the Index). The Fund will invest in, or gain exposure to shares of companies which make up the Index. The Fund qualifies under Article 8 of SFDR.


**Investment strategy**

The Index is designed to support investors seeking to reduce their exposure to transition and physical climate risks and who wish to pursue opportunities arising from the transition to a lower-carbon economy while aligning with the Paris Agreement requirements. It incorporates the task force on Climate-related Financial Disclosures recommendations and is designed to exceed the minimum standards of the EU Paris-Aligned Benchmark. The Fund is passively managed and aims to invest in the shares of the companies in the same proportion as in the Index. There may be circumstances when it is not possible for the Fund to invest in all constituents of the Index. If the Fund cannot invest directly in the companies that constitute the Index, it may gain exposure by using other investments such as depositary receipts, funds or derivatives. The Fund may invest up to 35% in securities from a single issuer during exceptional market conditions, up to 10% in total return swaps and contracts for difference, and up to 10% in other funds. **Main risks**

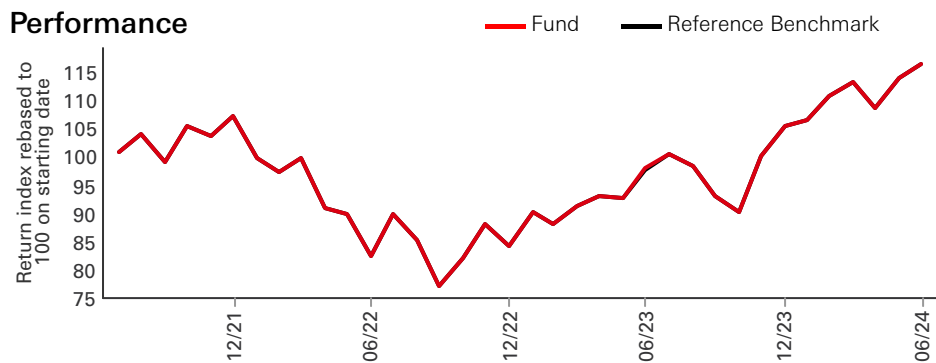

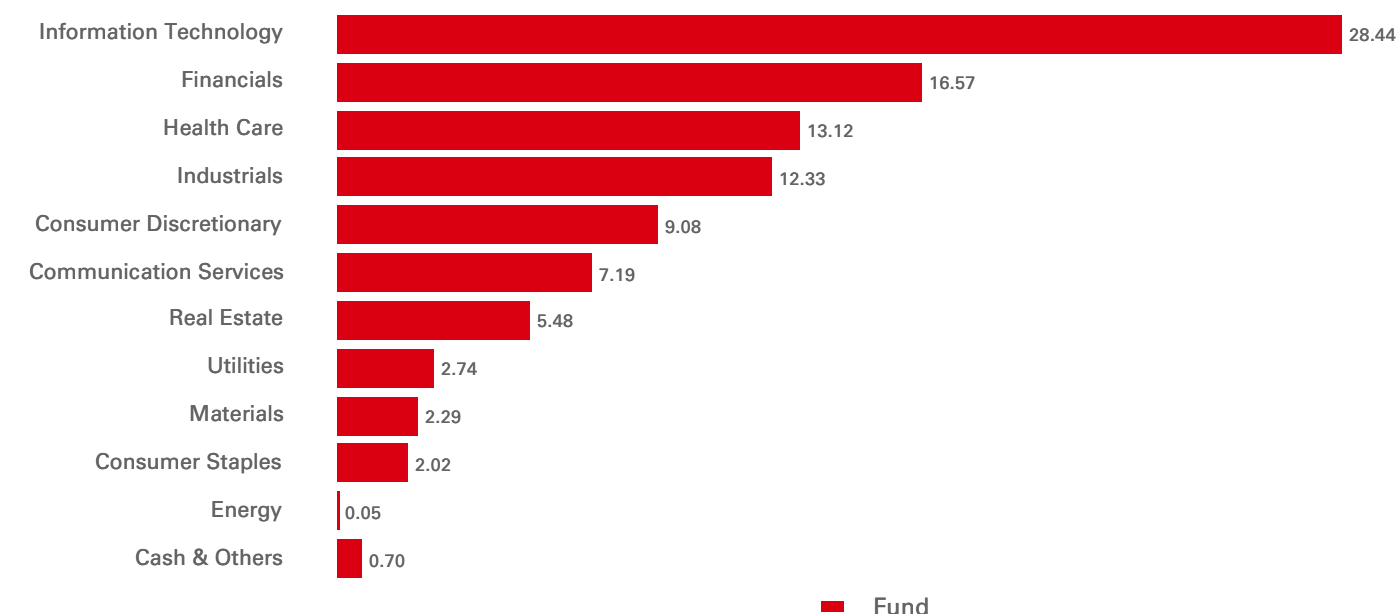

Sector allocation (%)

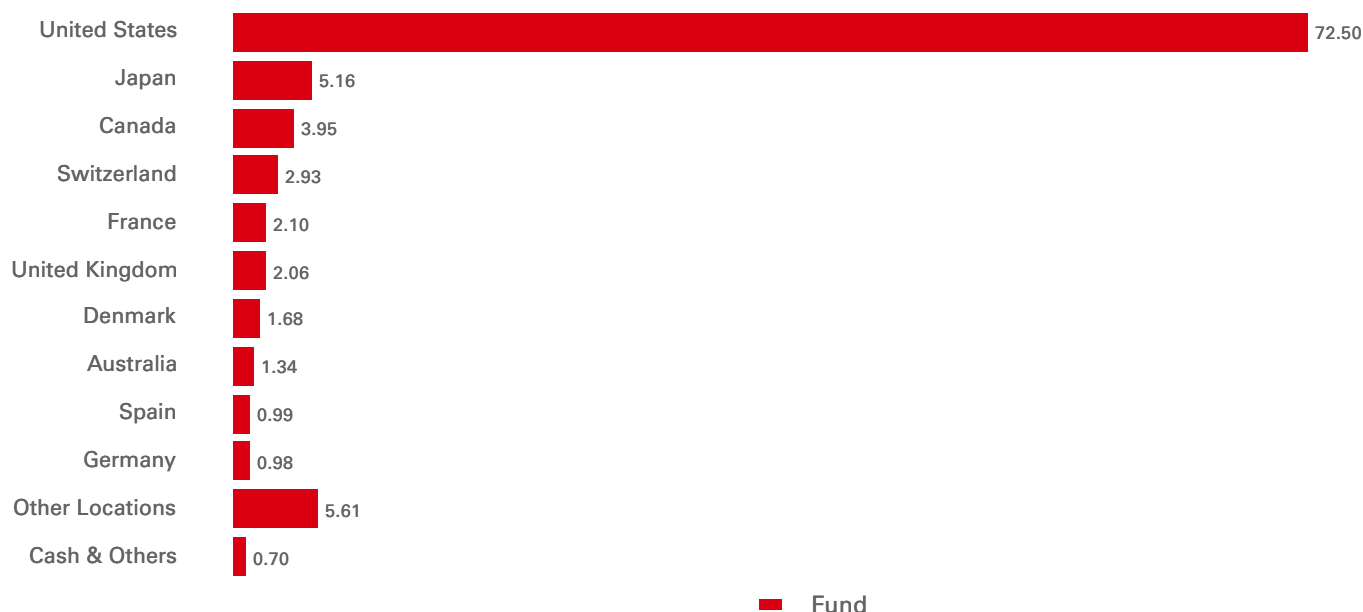

Company carbon data, can often be “partially disclosed”, i.e. partial geographic coverage, or incomplete operational data. Trucost\* undertakes analysis and research to assess company reported results. The proprietary Trucost model enables an estimate of total emissions which relies on more than just reported financial data. Where securities are not covered by Trucost, HSBC assigns a proxy value based on the average intensity score of comparable companies.\*Trucost are a division of S&P Global; they assess risks relating to climate change, natural resource constraints, and broader environmental, social, and governance factors.
