FUND OVERVIEW

- The Fund aims to provide a return on your investment (generated through an increase in the value of the assets held by the Fund) by tracking closely the performance of the FTSE 100 Index, the Fund's benchmark index.
- The Fund invests in equity securities (e.g. shares) of companies that make up the benchmark index.
- The benchmark index measures the performance of equity securities of the largest 100 companies listed in the United Kingdom. The benchmark index is a free float-adjusted market capitalisation weighted index. Free float-adjusted means that only shares readily available in the market rather than all of a company's issued shares are used in calculating the benchmark index. Free float-adjusted market capitalisation is the share price of a company multiplied by the number of shares readily available in the market.

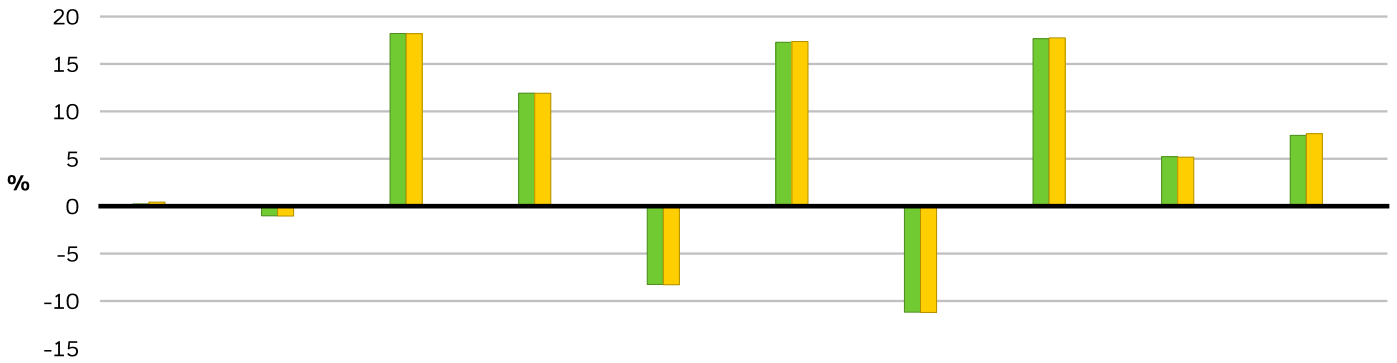

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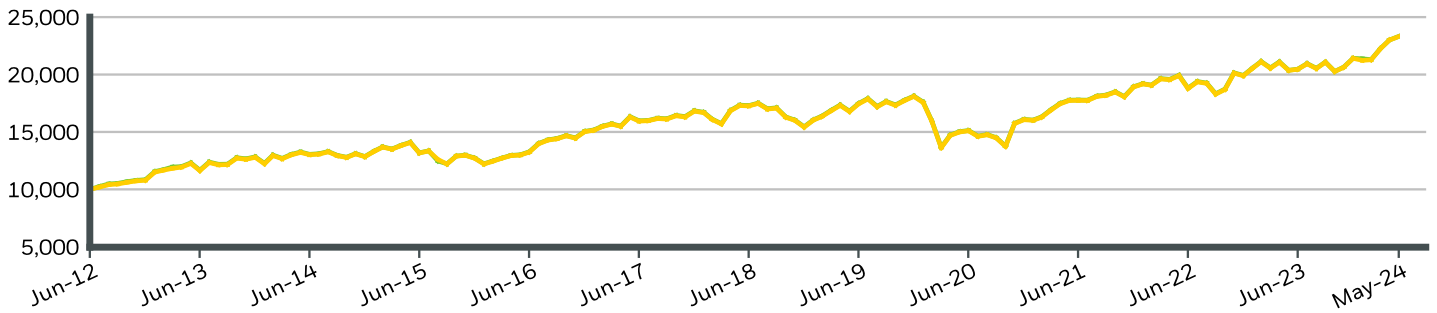

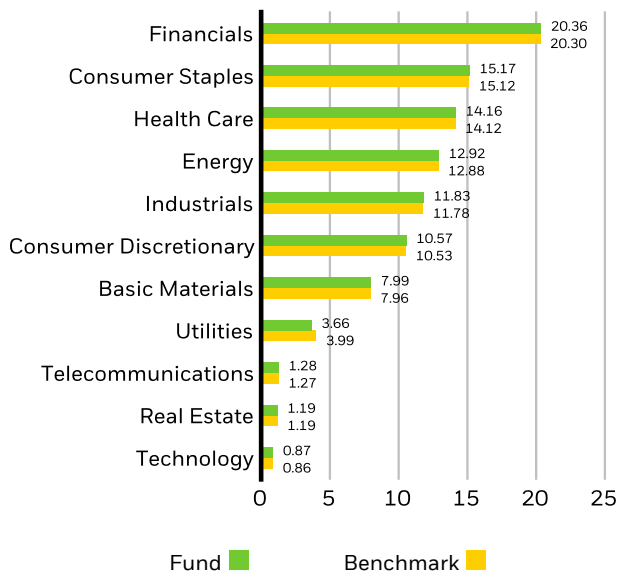

GEOGRAPHIC BREAKDOWN (%)

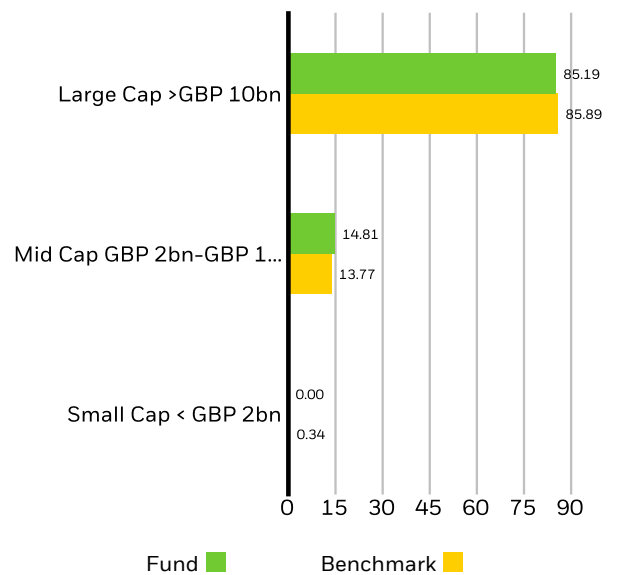
